

A previously unrecognized Valentinian solidus forgery

These are transfer die forgeries. On all examples, there is a comma shaped scratch behind the head on the obverse and some flan flaws before the nose. Outside the border of dots are remnants of the edge of the host coin. Most examples tend to be on the heavy side. Dirt deposits vary from coin to coin, some have no dirt.
