Assessment

- The central figure on the obverse is worn almost completely flat, appearing only as a faint silhouette against the field.
- Strike details are no longer present due to extreme circulation wear; only the basic outlines of the design remain.
- The surfaces are worn smooth from extensive use, and no environmental damage was detected. No plainly obvious deep scratches or distracting gouges are visible on the remaining surface area.

- There is no remaining mint luster; the surfaces have a dull, circulated brown patina typical for this type of copper issue.
- The overall eye appeal is poor to below average because of the significant loss of detail and rim integration.
- Final justification for this Estimated Digital Grade: The obverse exhibits rim wear that merges heavily into the peripheral areas and the date is barely discernable. While the reverse retains enough detail for a slightly higher assessment, the disparate wear between sides requires a cap at the AG-3 level.

Detailed Grade Factors

Strike: Weak - Most design elements have been worn smooth; only outlines of the central figure and wreath are visible.

Luster: None - The surfaces are completely brown and matte from circulation.

Surface Marks: Extensive small contact marks consistent with heavy circulation, but no plainly obvious deep scratches or distracting gouges were detected.

Wear Pattern: Significant rim integration on the obverse where the border has worn into the design and lettering; the reverse shows legend merging but the central denomination remains readable.

Eye Appeal: Poor - The coin is heavily worn and lacks detail, which is expected for this grade level.

Key Observations: The degree of rim wear on the obverse and the near-total loss of facial features are the primary factors in this assessment.
