

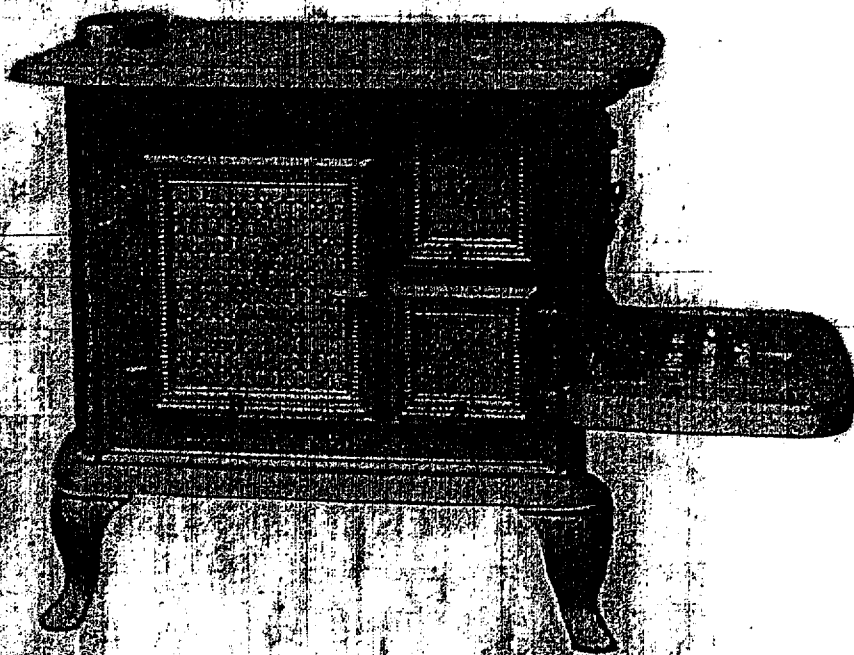

DESIGN FOR THE PLATES OF A COOKING-STOVE.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

To all whom it may concern :

Be it known that I, LUTHER W. HARWOOD, of the city of Troy, in the county of Rensselaer, and State of New York, have invented and produced a new and original Design for Plates of a Cooking-Stove, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying photograph of a cooking-stove, having my said design.

The distinguishing feature of my said design is a panel, A, representing a shingled surface, surrounded by a border moulding, B, all shaped and disposed on a door or doors, or a plate or plates of a cooking-stove,

so as to present an appearance like that represented in the accompanying photographic illustration.

What I claim as my invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for a door or doors, or a plate or plates of a cooking-stove, as herein shown and described.
